### Further Public Health Order exemptions for ANZAC Day

Two more exemptions to the Public Health Order have been granted in relation to ANZAC Day, following the [previous exemption announced last week](#).



The [first new exemption](#) allows any outdoor ANZAC Day march or service held in Greater Sydney between April 18-25 to have a maximum of 3,000 persons, subject to one person per 2 square metres of space.

The [second new exemption](#) allows the ANZAC Day march organised by RSL NSW held in the Sydney CBD on April 25 to have a maximum of 5,000 persons, subject to one person per 2 square metres of space.

All exemptions will be repealed on April 26.
