Updated Public Health Order requirements for ANZAC Day

Updated Public Health Order requirements to previous exemptions are now in place for outdoor ANZAC Day events and services between April 18 and 25.



These gatherings are limited to a maximum of 5,000 persons as COVID-19 safe outdoor public gatherings, subject to one person per 2 square metres of space.

The nominated organiser is exempted from using a contactless electronic method to collect contact details of participants at a march or service.

Each person participating must provide their contact details to the nominated organiser.

Spectators at a march are exempted from outdoor public gathering limits and the requirement to provide contact details.

A <u>separate exemption</u> is in place to allow the ANZAC Day march organised by RSL NSW held in the Sydney Central Business District on April 25 to have a maximum of 10,000 persons, subject to one person per 2 square metres of space.
