Updates to the Crown Land Manager Reserves Portal – 15 August 2018

The Crown Land Manager Reserves Portal (Phase 1) is being enhanced. In response to user feedback, the following functional changes are being incorporated:

| Portal Tool | Description of change |
|-------------------------|---|
| Filter by LGA | Now a selection from drop-down menu, no longer free-text. |
| Filter by Council | New Filter option - selection made by drop-down menu. |
| Query by Lot and DP | New Query option - selection made by entering text |
| Query by LGA | Now a selection from drop-down menu, no longer free-text. |
| Query by Council | New Query option - selection made by drop-down menu. |
| Extract Data by Council | Modification of previous tool - extract by LGA. |

<u>When</u>

The changes are expected to be deployed on Wednesday 15 August, commencing around 08:00am.

Duration

It is expected that all going well, the changes will be completed by 10:30am

User Impact

The portal will remain open during the change. The users may experience some minor impact as the changes are taking effect. This impact should be minimal and the portal still operational.

Feedback

Should issues remain in the portal later in the day or following days, Users are requested to report these issues back through the <u>feedback form</u> located on the Crown Lands website or via the 'About' page in the portal.

Plan of management training continues
