## Native title manager training

Department of Industry – Crown Lands recently sent an email advising that councils may nominate a relevant council officer to attend upcoming Native Title Manager Training which is occurring on two dates in June:

- Monday 3 June 2019, to be held in Sydney
- Wednesday 12 June 2019, to be held in Newcastle

The session will be run over a full day and delivered by the Crown Solicitors Office in conjunction with the Department of Industry - Crown Lands.

Please note that places are limited and preference will be given to those councils presently without a Native Title Manager. Nominees are those officers who will be responsible for providing native title advice.
